

RAPID FIRE SHOOT OUT RULES

1. This is a timed competition with only one team in the room at a time. No one other than the quizzers on that team, their head coach and the officials are allowed in the room (no spectators are allowed)
2. Ten point questions will be read by a quizmaster in a rapid manner. Quizmasters will need to be mindful of their pace so they use the same speed with each team.
3. The quizmaster will not stop the reading of a question if the quizzers interrupt, but will continue until they finish the question or they hear the correct answer.
4. Quizzers will not be using buzzers but will simply call out an answer as soon as they think they know the answer. All quizzers on the team may call out answers at the same time.
5. Quizzers will not be required to complete the question if they interrupt. They only need to give the answer.
6. Incorrect answers will be ignored. However, the quizmaster will not move on to the next question until a correct answer is given or the team says “pass” to move on.
7. There will be one or two judges to assist the quizmaster. Their role will be to listen for the correct answer and say “correct” as soon as they hear it.
8. The scorekeeper will make a tally mark on the score sheet for each question that the team gets correct, ie. not counting the ones that are passed on.
9. Each team is given 2 minutes on the timer to complete as many questions as they can. The timer begins with the first word of the first question.
10. Quizmasters will only say “Question for 10 points...” and not “Question, Question number 1 for 10 points....”
